

Seep Hose to Dripper Connection Leaks

Sometimes, due to variations in the production of the seep hose, the diameter of the internal pipe hole, is on the large size. This results in the connection between the dripper and seep hose leaking, causing over watering near the connection and a lack of water elsewhere.

There is a simple solution to this problem using short lengths of standard Irrigatia 3.5mm tube.



Use a piece of tube about 4cm long, with one end cut at an angle.



Push the square cut end over the dripper outlet.



Push the angled end firmly into the seep hose.

This process then needs to be repeated for the stopper, if being used on a single length.



Use a piece of tube about 4cm long, and push onto the stopper.



Push the other end into the seep hose.
